SECRETARY REPORT:

The Eleventh Concept states: "NA funds are to be used to fulfill our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly." Ideally, after paying for their expenses, groups send money directly to each level of service to help pay for the work done on their behalf. This example is one of many possible models groups can use. Some groups also set aside a small operating reserve (sometimes called a "prudent reserve"), often a month's rent or expenses. The Group Booklet cautions us that "too much money in the till causes far more trouble than too little money." 
