Rd Report (Regional Delegate). Went to Detroit for World Conference Report. All of the CAR (Conference agenda report) except for #5 which was about AI interaction. You can read the CAR motions on the world page. Motions import to be noted: Gender neutral language for material carried, #2 IP revised, Inmate tables provided. New Regions: Brazil, Rio Grande, Thailand, & Iran. They had a workshop on Diversity & welcoming newcomers (providing a format at homegroups, phone list, free book, pamphlet package, eating out after meeting, get newcomers involved in service (readings, chairing...)). He talked about having a "Recovery Fair" set up like a job fair (more being revealed in RCM meeting. Growth in the U.S. in Meetings is down by 1%. Ohio region has gone from 545 meeting to 445. There is potential growth in Africa; 54 countries there
